- Oak Grove – Town Shop V & M Intersection
- Brill – Village Park
- Loch Lomond – Next to Storage Area
- Mikana – Next to Old Cedar Lake Town Shop
- Cumberland – Behind Burger King *\*cardboard recycling at this location & NE Corner of Hwy 48 & 1<sup>st</sup> Ave*
- Stanfold – Town Shop at Hwy 25 & Hwy 48
- Almena – Behind Village Hall
- Turtle Lake – Railway Park *\*cardboard recycling at this location*
- Barron – Gordy’s Parking lot *\*cardboard recycling at this location & Behind Barron High School \*Cardboard only*
- Cameron – Behind Cameron Auto Body Shop *\*cardboard recycling at this location*
- Prairie Lake – Town Hall
- Chetek – Across from Water Treatment Plant on Water St *\*cardboard recycling at this location*
- Dallas - Behind Fire Hall
- Vance Creek – Next to Reeve Town Hall
- Prairie Farm – Town Shop North of Village

## ITEMS THAT CAN BE PLACED IN DROP-BOXES!

### GLASS CONTAINERS:

- We accept glass food jars and bottles, and glass beverage containers for recycling
- Glass of all colors can be mixed together and placed in the same section in the recycling drop-boxes
- Please remove caps and rinse out containers
- We do not accept any Porcelain or Ceramic, Crystal, Auto glass, safety glass, light bulbs or window pane glass for recycling

### PLASTIC CONTAINERS:

- We accept #1 and #2 plastics for recycling
- Look at the bottom of your container to see what plastic it is made from
- Please remove caps and rinse, no food filled items

### TIN/STEEL CANS:

- Tin and Steel food cans can be recycled
- Please remove labels and rinse cans clean

### ALUMINUM CANS:

- Aluminum cans can be recycled
- Please rinse clean

### CARDBOARD & MIXED PAPER

- At some drop-box locations we have bins for cardboard and paper recycling
- We do not accept any glossy print (like magazines or newspaper ads that are glossy), no bound books
- We accept Cardboard, Newspapers, Copy/Printer paper
- Paper and Cardboard go in the same bin

## ITEMS THAT MUST BE BROUGHT TO FACILITY TO BE RECYCLED:

- 1.) Batteries: We recycle car batteries for free
- 2.) Light Bulbs/Ballasts: There is a fee to recycle bulbs and ballasts
- 3.) Appliances: There is a fee to recycle appliances, and appliances with Freon in them
- 4.) Electronics: There is a fee to recycle electronic items
- 5.) Yard Waste: There is a fee to recycle yard waste - \*see information on how to prepare yard waste on our Waste to Energy Department page at [www.barroncountywi.gov](http://www.barroncountywi.gov)

### HELPFUL HINTS!

- Please do not place any food in our Drop-Boxes, they are emptied infrequently and this provides many sanitary issues. Many of the locations we have drop-boxes on are either public or private land, and we need to treat our neighbors respectfully!
- Do not place plastic bags in the drop-boxes, please empty your recycling items directly into the appropriate section

### **\*BARRON COUNTY RECYCLING ORDINANCE\***

- It applies to all of Barron County, EXCEPT the City of Rice Lake and Town of Rice Lake.
- It applies to all residences, multi-family residences, commercial and industrial entities
- It requires everyone separate and recycle the following items:
  1. Tin/Steel Containers
  2. Aluminum Containers
  3. Glass Containers
  4. #1 & #2 Plastics

### PENALTIES:

- 1<sup>ST</sup> OFFENSE \$50 FINE
- 2<sup>ND</sup> OFFENSE \$200 FINE
- 3<sup>RD</sup> AND SUBSEQUENT OFFENSES \$2000 FINE
