

RESOLUTION TO DISCONTINUE

PUBLIC WAY

The Town Board of the Town of Cedar Lake, Barron County, Wisconsin, by this resolution adopted by a majority of the Town Board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, resolves and declares as follows:

The public ways described below are to be discontinued under s.66.1003 (4), Wis. Stats. It is in the public interest of good planning and orderly development of the municipality that the public ways below are discontinued under S.66.1003 (4) Wis. Stat. The public ways to be discontinued are described as follows:

The public ways to be discontinued within the Plat of the Village of Mikana, Document 60096, recorded April 8th, 1902, in the Office of the Register of Deeds for Barron County, Wisconsin, being part of Southeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter, part of the Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section 21, Township 36 North, Range 10 West, Town of Cedar Lake, Barron County, Wisconsin, are more particularly described as follows;

The areas north of and adjacent to Blocks 1,2,3 and south of a portion of the un-lotted area within the Plat: All those portions of Balsam Street and Cedar Street north of the north line of Blocks 1,2,3 within the Plat, north of the already vacated portions of said Balsam and Cedar Streets; the entire alleys within Blocks 5 and 6 within the Plat; the alleys south of and adjacent to Blocks 8,9,10,11 and north of an un-lotted area within the Plat.

The town clerk shall properly post or publish this resolution as required by s.60.80, Wis. Stats. A hearing on the passage of the resolution shall be set by the Town Board on a date not less than 40 days from the date on which the resolution was introduced. Notice of the hearing will be served upon on all interested parties and published in accordance with the requirements of s.66.1003(4)(b) and s. 66.1003(8).
