

MONTHLY TOWN BOARD MEETING MINUTES

November 10 , 2025

Chairman Tony Wolff called the monthly meeting of the Town Board of Cedar Lake to order at 6:37 P.M. The meeting was held at the Cedar Lake Town Hall in Mikana. Present: Chairman Tony Wolff; Supervisors Kory Weiss and Jim Ludwig; and Treasurer Gladys Roux. There were 16 members of the public present.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

The minutes of the previous monthly meeting were read by Gladys. Tony made a motion to approve the minutes as presented; seconded by Kory. All in favor, Motion carried.

PUBLIC INPUT:

Tony extended thanks to Jim for power-washing the Town Hall. Tony commented that the Board, while not professional accountants, had made a good faith effort in preparing the Town budget .

FINANCIAL REPORT:

Treasurer Roux presented the financial report. Gladys noted a discrepancy of \$0.01 between the Treasurer's and Clerk's records, which will be reconciled.

ROAD REPORT:

Kory reported that invoices are anticipated from the County for road shouldering work and that new tires have been ordered for the backhoe.

BIRCHWOOD FOUR CORNERS EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT:

Don B. stated that there were 5 fire calls, 86 to date compared to 74 last year and 10 ambulance calls, 167 this year. The new Fire Chief will be Lance Neilsen, and the new Ambulance Director will be Samantha Zermaitis. Ken and Vince will remain with the department.

Kory discussed the rotation and funding from LRIP. Tony reported that the Town's lawsuit remains unresolved and is currently in the hands of our Lawyer. A discussion was held regarding the appointment of **Election Workers**, with formal approval to be scheduled for the next monthly meeting. Gladys reported that her official bond has been

received and is filed in the Treasurer's Office. Correspondence from Clerk Suzie Boumeester was presented to the Board.

Motion by Tony to adjourn the meeting and pay the bills; seconded by Kory. All in favor, Motion carried. The meeting was adjourned at 7:00 p.m.
