

Community Notice: Winter Road Conditions

Dear Residents,

I want to take a moment to acknowledge the concerns that have been raised regarding icy road conditions this winter. I understand the frustration and safety concerns many of you are experiencing, and I appreciate those who have taken the time to reach out.

This winter has been unusually difficult due to repeated cycles of rain, freezing temperatures, and refreezing, rather than the more typical snowfall we expect in northern Wisconsin. These conditions have resulted in an unprecedented buildup of ice and have required the use of more salt and sand mix in the past month than we would normally use in an entire winter season.

Adding to these challenges, the individual responsible for maintaining our roads has been dealing with illness, which has impacted response times. While this helps explain the situation, it does not excuse it. As Town Chairman, the responsibility ultimately rests with me, and I take that responsibility seriously.

We continue to monitor conditions closely, deploy resources as efficiently as possible, and respond to problem areas as quickly as circumstances allow. Living in northern Wisconsin means winter travel can be unpredictable at times, but that does not lessen our obligation to do everything reasonably possible to keep our roads safe.

Thank you for your patience and understanding during this challenging stretch of weather. I encourage residents to continue reporting specific trouble spots so they can be addressed as promptly as possible.
